





What about holidays?

Schools have the discretion to authorise up to 10 days absence per year.

Reporting absence

All absences must be reported.

The school's Education Welfare Officer visits school once a month to monitor pupils' attendance below 95%.

They asked for proof of all medical appointments taken during school time.
Please provide this when coming to collect your child for a medical appointment. Please can you support us in your child's attendance by trying to book medical appointments outside of school time as much as possible, or alternatively bring your child to school before or after the medical appointment.
